

## Solicitation of Public Comment Proposed Rate Increase for Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Rhode Island Medicare Supplement Insurance

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Rhode Island ("Blue Cross") has filed with the Office of the Health Insurance Commissioner (OHIC) its proposed rates for standardized Individual Medicare Supplement policies in Rhode Island. Blue Cross currently offers Plans A, B, C, F, G, N Select B, Select C, Select F, Select G and Select L.

Blue Cross proposes an average increase of 2.3% in its rates for these policies, although the proposed change varies by plan. There are 17,500 RI subscribers. The average expected loss ratio for this business is approximately 87.2% and varies by plan from 74.4% to 134.3%. Please see the below chart for a breakout of expected rate increases by Plan.

Additionally, effective July 1, 2021, Blue Cross intends to no longer offer Medigap A to new members outside of the six-month Medicare open enrollment period at age 65 and guaranteed issue open enrollments.
