

Solicitation of Public Comment Proposed Rate Increases for United Healthcare Insurance Co. Medicare Supplement Insurance

United Healthcare Insurance Company ("UHC") has filed with the Office of the Health Insurance Commissioner its proposed rates effective January 1, 2020 for its Individual Medicare Supplement policies marketed in Rhode Island under the AARP brand name. UHC intends to defer implementation of the increases until April 1, 2020. UHC proposes to introduce rating by gender for new enrollees as of April 1, 2020. This will not affect existing customers. If approved, female rates will decrease by approximately 6% and male rates will increase by approximately 8%, with an overall neutral effect.

Proposed rates are requested with respect to three categories of plans:

Pre-Standardized Plans

• 56 members

• Projected lifetime loss ratio: 85.6%

• Average rate increase: 1.3%

• Range of rate increase: 1.3% all plans

Standardized Plans Closed Block

• 2.634 members

• Projected lifetime loss ratio: 81%

• Average rate increase: 4.9%

• Range of rate increase: 4.5% to 5%

Standardized Plans Open Block

- 17.695 members
- Projected lifetime loss ratio 81%
- Average rate increase 5%
- Range of rate increase 4.5% to 9.6%
