Mutual of Omaha Insurance Company (Mutual) has filed with the Office of the Health Insurance Commissioner its proposed rates for its Individual Medicare Supplement policies sold in Rhode Island. They propose rate increases to be effective July 1, 2022 that vary by plan.

- Average rate increase of 6.7%, ranging from 0% to 10.0% by plan.

  - Plan C: 0%
  - Plan D: 10%
  - Plan F: 0%
  - Plan HDF: 4.5%
  - Plan G: 10%
  - Plan HDG: 0%
  - Plan N: 4.5%
