Code	Code Description	Number of Requests	Percentage Approved
S9131	Physical therapy, in the home, per diem	490	100%
S9123	Nursing care, in the home, by registered nurse, per hour	1886	99.90%
27447	Arthroplasty, knee, condyle & plateau; medial and lateral compartments, with or without patella resurfacing	583	99.40%
27130	Arthroplasty, acetubular/proximal femoral prosthetic replacement, with or without autograft/allograft	428	99.30%
64493	Injection(s) of diagnostic or therapeutic agent, paravertebral facet joint or nerves, with imaging guidance, lumbar or sacral, single level	584	95.40%

Part A

Remove prior authorization requirements from all medical services meeting the following criteria:

Average threshold average approval of 95% + & Average cost of \$25,000 or less Based on available reported data, the following codes meet the straw model criteria (based on cost data provided):

- 70553 (3,815 requests and 95.98% approval)
- 70551 (2,059 requests and 96.35% approval)
- 27447 (698 requests and 95.55% approval)

(based on secondary research for cost)

- 70486 (1,386 requests and 96.03% approval)
- 64493 (798 requests and 96.86% approval)
- 93306 (9,055 requests and 96.99% approval)
- 71271 (2,780 requests and 95.53% approval)

Timeframes for reporting

Clear and consistent timeframes for appeal deadlines for both payers and providers

Transparent and clear communication for all reporting

Clear avenue for communications on changes and requirements

Administrative denials

Ability to appeal for medical necessity on administrative denials


Increased consistency across timeframes for SNF approvals/denials


